Millions of women face unplanned pregnancies each year. In fact, over half of all pregnancies in the United States are unplanned. Often women facing an unplanned pregnancy feel pressure to "get out" of the situation as quickly as possible. Any decision made regarding your pregnancy should not be made hastily or without accurate information. For your own health and safety, we encourage you to make every effort to be completely and accurately informed. - Has your pregnancy been confirmed?
- Are you sure that you are not having a miscarriage or tubal pregnancy?
- Have you been tested recently for STIs?
- Do you feel like you have accurate information about abortion procedures?
- Are you aware of possible complications associated with abortion procedures?
- Have you confirmed the abortion clinic's procedures for any complications?
- If you need to be hospitalized due to complications with the abortion procedure, will your doctor have hospital-admission privileges?
- Are you aware of possible emotional side-effects connected with abortion?
